	<p>3.1 The Treasurer reported that the current balance stood at £3,665.</p> <p>3.2 The Handbook may be delayed as the print company H Brook has now gone out of business and an alternative supplier is being sought. The Treasurer is endeavouring to obtain the 'master' file to ease transfer.</p>

	<p>5.1 The 14 clubs present recounted intended entries for 2019. In addition to those provisionally identified in February, additional entries came from GHC [u17] and U Wharfedale [u9], however these were offset by reductions at Oakworth [u15] and Oxenhope [u9]. Bradley had advised their entry by email. No communication has been received from Cononley. A full list is shown below these minutes.</p> <p>5.2 The Executive extend a warm welcome to Harden CC, new club members of UAJCA this year.</p>	
6	UAJCA League Structure 2019	T Thompson
	<p>6.1 Members confirmed that the under-17 League and Spencer Cup would continue in 2019 with 5 teams. Skipton, Oakworth, Steeton, Bradford & Bingley and Great Horton Church</p> <p>6.1 The members approved an initial issue of fixtures for 5th May [Tour de Yorkshire] with the option to amend should the departure times make travel arrangements impossible</p> <p>6.2 After extended discussion members voted 6-4 in favour of adopting the Wind-ball for under-9 cricket in 2019. This confirms helmets & protective clothing is not compulsory as per 2018 approval. Abdominal protectors must be worn by all players.</p> <p>6.3 After discussion members voted 9-0 in favour of adopting <i>all</i> the ECB-recommended pitch lengths. However a review at the November meeting will be held.</p> <p>6.4 After discussion the members voted 12-0 to adopt Regulation 41.7 with regard to 'beamers'.</p> <p>6.5 After discussion the members voted unanimously to allow Girls to play 2 years beyond the limits set for boys. See Rule XXX</p>

	<p>7.1 Settle withdrew their application to host a Grand Final Day. Under Rule XXX adopted at the earlier EGM, Wilsden were awarded a Finals Day and they were joined by Skipton when Steeton also withdrew.</p> <p>7.2 Skipton were only able to host the 2nd Finals day on 30th June and Wilsden agreed to host the First event on 23rd June.</p> <p>7.3 The Cup draws were conducted by The Treasurer with help from the members present. The full draws are attached.</p> <p>7.4 The Chairman read out the 2019 rota clubs to provide Umpires for the two Finals days. They were: Bradford & Bingley, Cononley, Earby Embsay, Steeton, Sutton, U Wharfedale and Wilsden</p>

	<p>8.1 The following entries were confirmed at the meeting:</p> <p>Under-9 Oakworth [holders], Steeton, Skipton, Earby, Harden & Crossflatts, who would be joined by 'guest' invitees Lower-House and Bilton [Total 8, 2 vacancies]</p> <p>Under-11 First Cricket [holders], Oxenhope, Crossflatts, Steeton, Embsay, Skipton, Oakworth & Earby in addition to guest invitees Lower-house and Bilton [Total 10, no vacancies]</p> <p>Under-13 Oakworth [holders], Steeton, Embsay, Skipton, Earby & Oxenhope in addition to guest invitees First Cricket, Lower-house & Bilton [Total 9, 1 vacancy]</p> <p>8.2 The Secretary confirmed that a new under-9 Representative Festival, with a new format, is currently being arranged for 8 teams [8-aside]. Teams confirmed to date: UAJCA A & B, Huddersfield A & B, Nidderdale A & B, Heavy Woollen [1 team] [Total 7, 1 vacancy]. It is hoped the vacancy will be filled soon.</p> <p>8.3 A provisional date of 11th August has been set for the 2nd UAJCA Girls Festival. A venue is sought [capable of splitting for 2 concurrent matches]. Format are yet to be finalised.</p>

	The Secretary thanked those clubs who have already supplied contact details for team managers in 2019 and again requested all other by 28 th March, according to rule 2.8.	

10	2019 UAJCA Representative Cricket	T Thompson
	<p>10.1 The Secretary confirmed that the UAJCA trials for u9, u10, u11, u12 and u13 would be held indoors at South Craven School Sports Hall on Sunday 7th April with all team manager-coaches attending.</p> <p>10.2 The Joe Lumb manager confirmed that the u17 trail will be held outdoors at Oxenhope CC Nets on Sunday 28th April, commencing 1:15pm.</p> <p>10.3 The intention is to hold an outdoor net for u15s in mid-May. A date has not yet been fixed. After failing to receive a reply from Silsden CC, the Secretary asked clubs to consider allowing their nets to be 'hired' for this important trial. Please email the Secretary as soon as possible.</p> <p>10.4 The Secretary confirmed that this year the Turf India Group from New Delhi will contest 3 teams from UAJCA at u10, u12 & u14, all on the 19th June [6:00pm] at Wilsden, Harden and Bingley Congs. A curry special!!</p> <p>10.5 The Secretary put forward a proposal to properly thank all Representative match Umpires for their services when operating outside our Area. He proposed a £20 per match amount of expenses. The meeting agreed it was a welcome move subject to approval of sufficient funds from the Treasurer.</p> <p>10.6 The Secretary outlined significant changes to the Play-Cricket sites & system, which have followed GDPR. Clubs will now need to ask parents to sign up to P-C as a member in order to facilitate its communications data protection and that if their child is under-16, to add the child's registration as an adjunct to the parent. In this way increases in administrative workload for both clubs and UAJCA can be avoided.</p> <p>10.7 The Secretary & Treasurer reported on the quotations, which include provision of £200 sponsorship of UAJCA, from MC Sports and Dobson & Robinson for the 2019 Representative Clothing supply. Financially there was benefit financially only if 'sublimated' kit was purchased by parents. D & R declined to offer the sublimated option. After discussion it was proposed by the Treasurer that UAJCA award the supply of sublimated kit to M C Sports for under-9s only in 2019. The supply of traditional kit [Gunn & Moore] will remain with Dobson & Robinson for 2019 for u10, u11, u12, u13, 15 & u17 teams but with the requirement to reduce stocks so that following a review in November 2019, a clearer picture of the kit requirements for future years can be taken. No volunteers to design the kit were received.</p>

	<p>12.1 The Secretary outlined that Richard Wilkinson [YCB Devt Manager] is to hold a consultative meeting with clubs who have interest in helping drive expansion of the Womens & Girls game in the Area.</p> <p>12.2 The Secretary reported that following his apology to Cononley CC on the mix-up regarding meeting venues, a response had been received from Mr Calvert, the Cononley CC Chairman. The Secretary had offered to again utilise Cononley CC but the offer had not yet been accepted.</p> <p>12.3 The Steeton representative raised an issue relating to match re-arrangement regulation. The Secretary advised that he needed to prepare a form of words, which could be submitted before 1st November for discussion at the next meeting [Nov].</p>
